OCONEE COUNTRY CLUB FOOTGOLF COURSE RULES

- 1. No soccer cleats are allowed. Turf shoes or tennis shoes allowed.
- 2. Play the ball as it lies unless it interferes with the play of another ball. In which case, mark and lift and then replace.
- 3. The player farthest away from the hole is the first to kick (Do not kick if it is possible to hit the group in front.)
- 4. If the ball in play is moved or deflected or stopped by another ball, the player must play his ball as it lies and replace the ball moved. No penalty unless both balls are on the green in which case the player who hit incurs a penalty of two strokes. Balls on the green should be marked before the player farthest away plays.
- 5. A player must not make a stroke while another ball is in motion.
- 6. Loose impediments (branches, leaves, rocks, etc.) can be removed. If the ball moves, the player incurs a 1 stroke penalty.
- 7. Movable obstructions (rakes, fallen branches, etc.) can be removed without penalty.
- 8. Immovable obstructions: You can lift and drop a ball without penalty but not nearer the hole. Example: A sign, fence, sprinkler head, under a cart, etc.
- 9. If your ball is in a sand hazard, you may play it or take a 1 stroke penalty and drop out no nearer the hole.
- 10. If your ball is unplayable (in a tree, bush, etc.) you may play the ball from the spot of your previous stroke, drop a ball behind the point where the ball lies in a straight line to the flag or drop within the length of 2 yards from where the ball lies, not nearer the hole and incur a 1 stroke penalty.
- 11. If the ball lies on the putting green used for regular golf, the ball must be removed and dropped off the green within 10 feet no closer to the footgolf hole.
